English

This term in English we will be exploring different kinds of texts and focusing on these areas of narratives:

We will also be focusing on cursive handwriting, capital letters and punctuation.

Maths

In Maths, Year 1 will learn maths following the Maths No Problem scheme. This scheme is based on the highly effective, research based Singapore method of teaching mathematics. The children will be covering key concepts such as simple addition and subtraction within 20, position and Direction, shape, patterns, height and length.

Science

The children will identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body.

The children will learn about the four seasons, the compass, directions and where is the UK in the world.
