

# YEAR 3



## Autumn Term 2

### English

This term in English we will be writing in a variety of genres such as prediction, persuasive writing and poetry. Our fiction writing will include a narrative based on the book 'Mouse, Bird, Snake, Wolf.' Their learning will include a clear focus on the skills of drafting and editing. Year 3 will continue to develop their knowledge of different forms of punctuation and grammatical terms and how these can be used to improve their writing.

### Maths

In Maths, Year 3 will continue to learn maths following the Maths No Problem scheme. This scheme is based on the highly effective, research based Singapore method of teaching mathematics. The children will be covering key concepts such as addition and subtraction. In multiplication they will be learning the 3's, 4's and 8 timetables. They will cover division alongside this as well as length, mass and volume.

### Science

In Science, the year 3 topic is Forces and Magnets. The children will learn how things move on different surfaces with a focus on the force friction. They will describe magnets as having two poles and observe how magnets attract or repel each other

### We will also be learning:

#### History

We will be learning about the changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. The children explore a timeline and place AD and BC accurately.

#### Music

The children's learning will be based around developing play skills. They will learn how to use and play the glockenspiels.

#### PSHE

We will be exploring the topic 'Health and wellbeing.' The children will learn how to have a healthy lifestyle and explore identities and what it feels like to be part of a group.

#### French

We will be exploring the topic 'All about me.' The children will learn basic phrases that are used in the classroom and learn names of school subjects in French.

#### Design and Technology

We will be learning and applying two new sewing techniques cross stitch and applique. The children will make their very own cushions.

#### R.E

We will be exploring Christianity and looking at the Holy Trinity which describes the nature of God.
