<p><b>Maths</b> In Maths, Year 3 will continue to learn maths following the Maths No Problem scheme. This scheme is based on the highly effective, research based Singapore method of teaching mathematics. The children will be covering key concepts such as money, time, pictograms and bar charts.</p>	
<p><b>Science</b> In Science, the year 3 topics Light and Shadows. The children will recognise how shadows are formed. They will find patterns in the way that the size of a shadow changes by carrying out a variety of investigations.</p>	
<p><b>We will also be learning:</b></p> <p><b>History</b> In History the children will be learning about The Romans. The children will learn all about the Roman Empire and the impact it left on Britain. They will use a variety of sources and artefacts to enhance their understanding.</p> <p><b>Music</b> The children will be looking at the Dragon Song which is all about kindness, respect, friendship and acceptance. The children will improvise and compose music.</p> <p><b>PSHE</b> The children will be learning about Citizenship and what rights children have. They will explore why we have rules and the roles of local community groups and charities play. They will begin to learn about local democracy.</p> <p><b>French</b> The children will be learning all about Family and Friends. They will learn how to name family members, friends and even pets.</p> <p><b>Design and Technology</b> The children will be exploring Cooking and Nutrition. They will look at eating seasonally and explore how different fruit and veg are cooked in different parts of the world as well design and make a seasonal dish.</p> <p><b>Religious Education</b> Children will be exploring Judaism and look at how festivals and worship matters to a Jew. They will explore Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur.</p> <p><b>PE</b> The children will explore Gymnastics this half term. In this unit pupils focus on improving the quality of their gymnastic movements</p>
