English

This term in English we will be exploring different kinds of texts and focusing on these areas of narratives:

- **Informal letter**
- **Wanted poster**
- **Setting description**
- **Poetry**

We will also be focusing on cursive handwriting, capital letters and punctuation.

Maths

In Maths, Year 1 will learn maths following the Maths No Problem scheme. This scheme is based on the highly effective, research based Singapore method of teaching mathematics. The children will be covering key concepts such addition and subtraction, height and length and multiplication.

Science

In Science, the year 1 topic:

Introduction to plants

The children will identify and name some common plants – including deciduous and evergreen trees.

We will also be learning:

Geography What is it like to live in Shanghai?

The children will learn about their local area and make a map. They will then learn about Shanghai and what it is like to live there.
