Their fiction writing will include a narrative based on the popular novel 'The Iron Man.' Their learning will include a clear focus on ensuring they have all key features taught displayed in their work. Year 3 will continue to continue their knowledge of different forms of punctuation and grammatical terms. <p>Maths In Maths, Year 3 will continue to learn maths following the Maths No Problem scheme. This scheme is based on the highly effective, research based Singapore method of teaching mathematics. The children will be covering key concepts such as pictograms, bar charts, fractions, angles and perimeter.</p>	
<p>Science In Science, the year 3 topic plant reproduction. The children will learn about seed formation and the four methods of seed dispersal. They will investigate the way in which water is transported within plants.</p>	
<p>We will also be learning:</p> <p>Geography In Geography the he children will learn about settlements and study how land is used in their local area. They will also look into how the local area has changed over time.</p> <p>Music The children will be looking at the song - Bringing Us Together. This is a disco song about friendship, peace, hope and unity. Children learn about the dimensions of music (pulse, rhythm, pitch etc...) singing and playing instruments are all linked.</p> <p>PSHE The children will be learning about Citizenship and what rights children have. They will explore why we have rules and the roles of local community groups and charities play. They will begin to learn about local democracy.</p> <p>French The children will learn how to say various school items in French. They will learn how to pronounce their favourite subject and know what classroom resources are in French.</p> <p>Art The children will be exploring drawing.. They will look techniques of artists such as Georgia O'Keefe and traditional Chinese painters to draw natural forms, becoming aware of differences in the choice of drawing medium, scale and the way tonal shading can help create form.</p> <p>Religious Education The children will be exploring Christianity in particular focussing on the creation story. They will explore story and create a timeline of events.</p> <p>PE The children will learn how to play tennis. They will learn how to hold a racket, how to play the forehand and back alongside the rules of the game.</p>
