<p>English This term in English we will be writing a variety of non-fiction genres in addition to a range of descriptive passages. Their fiction writing will culminate in a narrative based on 'Fireweed'. Learning will include a clear focus on the skills of drafting and editing. <p>Maths In Maths, Year 6 will continue to learn maths following the Maths No Problem scheme. This scheme is based on the highly effective, research based Singapore method of teaching mathematics. The children will be covering key concepts such as place value along with more problem based questions that will require them to use all four operations.</p>	
<p>Science In Science, the year 6 topic is electricity and circuits. The children will be revisiting electrical circuits, children learn to draw conventional circuit diagrams and use models to explain current, resistance and voltage. They will compare different batteries and relate this to the effects on bulb brightness.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">We will also be learning:</p> <p><u>History</u> We will be debating who should go on banknotes. The children will consider the significance of various historical figures and will give reasons for validating each one's claim to feature on a banknote.</p> <p><u>Geography</u> Children will be carrying out an independent fieldwork enquiry. The children will devise their own enquiry question and find suitable ways to collect the data. They will map out their route, collect their own data and analyse their findings.</p> <p><u>Music</u> They will learn the dimensions of music along with singing and playing instruments.</p> <p><u>PSHE</u> We will be exploring the topic 'safety and the changing body'</p> <p><u>French</u> Year 6 will be studying the unit 'Visiting a French town'.</p> <p><u>Art</u> Photography. Exploring photography as a medium for expressing ideas, pupils investigate scale and composition, colour and techniques for adapting finished images. They use digital media to design and create photographic imagery for a specific design brief.</p> <p><u>RE</u> Year 6 will be learning about what kind of King Jesus was.</p> <p><u>PE</u> This half term year 6 will be learning key skills in athletics and rounders.</p>
