<p>English This term in English we will be writing a variety of genres including non-chronological reports and poetry,</p> <p>Their fiction writing will include a narrative based on 'The Owl who is afraid of the dark. Their learning will include a clear focus on consolidating all the key skills they need to be proficient in English. Year 3 will continue their knowledge of different forms of punctuation and grammatical terms. <p>Maths In Maths, Year 3 will continue to learn maths following the Maths No Problem scheme. This scheme is based on the highly effective, research based Singapore method of teaching mathematics. The children will be covering key concepts like fractions, angles, perimeter and geometry.</p>	
<p>Science In Science, the year 3 topic will be exploring hand span along with carrying out a variety of experiments that tests their own strength. The children will also have a revision of all key concepts taught throughout the year.</p> <p>We will also be learning:</p> <p>History In History the children will be learning about The Egyptians. The children will learn all about the ancient civilisation and explore a variety of artefacts along with learning about what impact they had.</p> <p>Music The children will have music lessons led by Mr Turner.</p> <p>PSHE The children will be exploring economic wellbeing along with transition thinking about the importance of money, how they manage it and what are healthy spending habits. They will also explore the change from Year 3</p> <p>Design and Technology The children will be exploring mechanical systems and make their very own pneumatic toy. They will plan their design, use a variety of resources to create and then evaluate.</p> <p>French The children will be learning about time in French along with consolidating all of their learning from the year.</p> <p>Religious Education The children will be exploring how people make the world a better place and will take a thematic view looking at a variety of faiths and teachings.</p> <p>PE The children will take part in rounders and athletics this half term working on key skills to help them learn more about the sports.</p>
